This is piano accompaniment for all 4 verses of this stately and well-loved hymn. Voices should sing in unison as the chord structure differs from that written in the hymnal. Or, better yet, try it with the beautiful arrangement found in the January 2000 issue of the **New Era** Magazine. For ease of rehearsal, write the same measure numbers indicated in this arrangement on the score of the vocal arrangement.
